2. Salmon Methodology Review: Final Prioritization of Modeling Issues for Scientific and Statistical Committee:

***Other STT Issues.***

1. Update on status of Fisheries Regulation Assessment Model (FRAM) Documentation:  
During the Salmon Methodology Review item, the MEW should be prepared to brief the Council on progress toward documenting the FRAM.
2. FRAM calculated Individual Stock Based Management (ISBM) Indices:  
There has been a suggestion that the FRAM be modified to calculate ISBM indices to allow the Council to check compliance with provisions of the Pacific Salmon Treaty during the preseason planning process.
