

Regulations for recreational fishing from Queets River, Washington to Cape Falcon, Oregon (Westport and Columbia River subareas) have been adjusted by inseason action. The Columbia River area will reopen Sunday, September 2, 2007 with all previously announced restrictions, except that the coho quota has been changed. Effective Sunday September 2, 2007 there will be a transfer of 10,000 coho from the Westport subarea with a resulting increase in the Columbia River coho subarea quota of 8,400. This modifies the Westport subarea coho quota to 28,510 and the Columbia River subarea coho quota to 71,450. The Columbia River subarea will remain open until September 30 or attainment of the subarea quota as previously announced.
