

UPDATE OF ONGOING FISHERIES

Situation: A summary of the management events for the 2001 salmon season (updated through June 4) is contained in Supplemental Attachment B.2.a. Through May, there have been two inseason management conferences to adjust fisheries. The most recent conference involved tracking of the May non-Indian commercial troll fishery in the Fort Bragg area, which closed on May 21 after reaching the chinook harvest quota of 3,000 fish.

Mr. Allen Grover, Vice Chair of the Salmon Technical Team (STT), will provide detailed effort and harvest data for salmon fisheries through May in his report to the Council.
