

AMENDMENT 10 TO THE COASTAL PELAGIC SPECIES FISHERY MANAGEMENT PLAN

Situation: The Council will consider final adoption of Amendment 10 to the Coastal Pelagic Species (CPS) Fishery Management Plan (FMP). Amendment 10 addresses two separate CPS-related issues: (1) capacity goal and permit transferability in the limited entry fishery and (2) determination of a maximum sustainable yield (MSY) proxy for market squid. In compliance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), Amendment 10 is written in the form of a combined Environmental Assessment/Regulatory Impact Review (EA/RIR).

The Council reviewed and adopted a public review draft of Amendment 10 at the March 2002 meeting. Beginning April 22, 2002, Council staff distributed the review draft of Amendment 10 to the interested public and National Marine Fisheries Service. As of May 31, 2002, 1 comment was received.

The CPS Management Team (CPSMT) will briefly review Amendment 10. The CPS Advisory Subpanel (CPSAS) will provide recommendations to the Council.

Council Action:

1. **Adopt Amendment 10 to the CPS FMP.**
