

SALMON ADVISORY SUBPANEL REPORT ON SCIENTIFIC AND STATISTICAL COMMITTEE
METHODOLOGY REVIEW PRIORITIES

The Salmon Advisory Subpanel has discussed the proposed methodology reviews listed in Exhibit D.3.a and have determined only number 5, Fishery Regulation Assessment Models (FRAMs) for Mark-Selective Fisheries, will be ready for review prior to the November Council meeting. The chinook FRAM has reportedly been modified by Mr. Jim Packer to accommodate mark-selective fisheries using methodologies similar to that of the coho FRAM. In addition to modeling harvest impacts, effects of mark-selective fisheries on the coast-wide coded-wire tag database are of concern.

The remainder of the Methodology Reviews listed in D.3.a are not ready for review at this time.
