

HIGHLY MIGRATORY SPECIES ADVISORY SUBPANEL REPORT ON  
RESPONSE TO OVERFISHING OF BIGEYE TUNA

The Highly Migratory Species Advisory Subpanel (HMSAS) is concerned that the Council's actions on bigeye tuna may limit West Coast fisheries and set a precedent for other highly migratory species fisheries.

The HMSAS agreed that there is a need for increased cooperation between the Council and the Western Pacific Fishery Management Council and asks the Pacific Council for an update on joint activities.
