We would like to invite the Scientific and Statistical Committee's Ecosystem-Based Management Subcommittee to join us at this meeting. The HC would hear presentations on a recent California Current ecosystem management workshop convened by Communication Partnership for Science and the Sea (COMPASS) and hear from individuals from the Northwest Fisheries Science Center's Ecosystem Program that are working on these issues. The HC would then prepare a report for the Council's potential April Essential Fishery Management Plan agenda item.
