GROUNDFISH ADVISORY SUBPANEL REPORT ON FUTURE WORKLOAD PLANNING

The Groundfish Advisory Subpanel (GAP) discussed future workload planning issues and offers the following comments.

- 1. <u>Strike the midwater recreational fishery item from November and move this to March</u>. In accordance with Council action, it will be on the March agenda for final action. The GAP requests this definitely remain on the March agenda.
- 2. <u>Move the vessel movement monitoring issue to March</u>. This would allow for an Enforcement Consultants report on the testing of new or enhanced vessel monitoring equipment, which in turn would allow for more robust GAP discussion and comments.
- 3. <u>The GAP requests a National Marine Fisheries Service update in November</u> on the Pacific Dawn appeal or other issues that may affect changes in the progression of groundfish items or regulations implementation.
