## SALMON MANAGEMENT SCHEDULE FOR 2016

To plan, announce, and meet *Federal Register* deadlines for public hearing sites and the entire preseason salmon management process, staff needs to confirm details of the process prior to the end of November 2015. The proposed 2016 process and schedule are contained in Agenda Item D.3, Attachment 1.

For 2016, Council staff recommends one salmon management alternatives hearing per coastal state. The hearings would be:

March 28, 2016 Westport, Washington and Coos Bay, Oregon

March 29, 2016 Ft. Bragg, California

In 2016, the March Council meeting will occur in Sacramento, California and the April Council meeting in Vancouver, Washington. Therefore, the public comment period regarding the tentative adoption of management measures for analysis at the April meeting in Vancouver also serves as a public comment opportunity. If the states desire to have additional hearings, we suggest they organize and staff them as was done in past years. The table below provides the public attendance at the hearing sites since 2001, for Council reference.

At the September 2015 Council meeting, the Council discussed the status of Sacramento River winter Chinook (SRWC) and plans for the management of this stock beyond 2016. During that discussion, the Council decided to move forward with forming an ad hoc workgroup and developing a proposed schedule to explore an alternative SRWC harvest policy for the future (Agenda Item D.3, Attachment 2). It is anticipated that appointments to an ad hoc workgroup and the approval of a final schedule will occur at the November 2015 Council meeting.

- 2. Approve staff's overall proposed schedule and process for developing 2016 ocean salmon management measures.
- 3. Consider membership and 2016 schedule for the ad hoc Sacramento River Winter Chinook Workgroup.
