Pacific Council to Adopt Overfishing Limits and Acceptable Biological Catches for the 2017-18 Groundfish Fishery and Other Matters Affecting West Coast Fisheries November 13-19, 2015

The Pacific Fishery Management Council (Council) and its advisory bodies will meet November 13-19, 2015 in Garden Grove, California to address issues related to management of groundfish, coastal pelagic species, highly migratory species, salmon, Pacific halibut, and habitat matters.

Listed below are some key agenda items, which include Council considerations to:

- In the groundfish fishery: 1) final approval of stock assessments and 2017-2018 fishery management
 specifications and management measures for further analysis; 2) adopt final whiting electronic
 monitoring alternative and implementing regulations; 3) adopt reallocation and accumulation limits
 for the blackgill-slope complex and; 4) adopt inseason adjustments to the current groundfish fishery.
- Consider results of the Pacific sardine distribution workshop, provide guidance for 2016 methodology review topics, and adopt 2016 experimental fishing permits for public review.
- Consider swordfish management policy connections.
- Adopt a 2016 salmon management schedule and final methodology changes.
- Adopt changes to the 2016 Pacific halibut catch sharing plan and annual fishing regulations.
