## WEST COAST REGIONAL OPERATING AGREEMENT FINAL REVIEW

In September 2015, the National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS) released final Operational Guidelines (OG), which provided guidance on development, review, and implementation of Federal fishery management plans, amendments, regulations, and for content of Regional Operating Agreements (ROAs). ROAs are documents that describe roles and responsibilities of the regional Council staff and its corresponding NMFS/National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) General Counsel regional partners in planning, developing, and approving fishery management plans, amendments, and regulations.

The Pacific Fishery Management Council (Council) and NMFS West Coast partners have an ROA that was signed in 2013. The current ROA was intended to document existing processes and not to impose any desired changes in the roles and responsibilities of the parties. The new OG requires parties to review their ROA by 2016, and provide the opportunity to revise the ROA to update procedures and make any desired changes. At its September meeting the Council discussed potential revisions to the ROA, with the objective of finalizing a new ROA at the November 2016 Council meeting. Council staff has coordinated with NMFS and has recommended only a few minor changes to the ROA for Council consideration (Agenda Item G.2, Attachment 1)
