

California Sea Lions

Forage in focus: California Sea Lions

- An on-going investigation into a significant mortality event since 2013
- Female sea lions giving birth to underweight pups and unable to rear them
- Thousands of pups stranding annually, swamping rehab centers
- A resource issue: females unable to source nearby fish to sustain them
- Fishery depletion exacerbated by ocean temperature change in the face of climbing sea lion populations

Guadalupe Fur Seals

Forage in focus: Guadalupe Fur Seals

- An investigation into a significant mortality event for 2015 and 2016
- 32 seals in 2015 at TMMC and 32 in 2016
- Prior to this, the highest since 1975 was 5 in a single year
- Primary food source: squid
- Shifting prey selection an added pressure?
