Changes to Council Operating Procedures

Council staff has been working on improving the process for submitting supplemental public comment at Council meetings. The new proposals are intended to clarify and streamline the process so that supplemental public comments submitted at Council meetings enter the record more efficiently and more effectively. The proposals do not substantially change procedures for submitting written material for the advanced Council Briefing Book or the supplemental public comment distribution at the onset of a Council meeting. Rather, the newly proposed procedures focus on written testimony submitted at a Council meeting in support of oral testimony. Additionally, the Legislative Committee has recommended adding language to COP 1 regarding its membership and officers. Implementing these changes requires changes to COP 1 concerning general Council meeting operations (Agenda Item C.3, Attachment 1).

At its March 2017 meeting, the Council discussed revisions to COP 20 regarding the deadline for submitting exempted fishing permit (EFP) applications for highly migratory species (Agenda Item C.3, Attachment 2). The proposal is to require application submission by the advanced briefing book public comment deadline prior to the Council meeting at which the application will be considered.

The Council reviewed the proposed revisions to COP 1 and COP 20 at its March meeting and adopted them for public review before potential final adoption at the April Council meeting.
