LEGISLATIVE MATTERS

The Legislative Committee (LC) will meet on Thursday, June 8, 2017, to review bills proposed in the 115th Congress (Agenda Item C.3, Attachment 1). A new bill that would make changes to the Magnuson-Stevens Act has been submitted (HR 2023); a summary is provided (Attachment 2). Attachment 3 (electronic only) shows the changes proposed by HR 200 and HR 2023. A California Senate bill is also attached for Legislative Committee (LC) discussion (Attachments 4 and 5).

In April 2017, the Council approved a letter in responses to Representative Jaime Herrera-Beutler's request for comment on HR 200, the Strengthening Fishing Communities and Increasing Flexibility in Fisheries Management Act; that letter is attached (Attachment 6).
