

**HIGHLY MIGRATORY SPECIES ADVISORY SUBPANEL REPORT ON
PROPOSED DEEP-SET BUOY GEAR EXEMPTED FISHING PERMITS**

The Highly Migratory Species Advisory Subpanel (HMSAS) generally agrees with Highly Migratory Species Management Team comments and recommendations on the 19 deep-set buoy gear permit applications, but has its own specific comments in the table below.

The HMSAS recommends that priority be given to renewal applications, applications from experienced commercial fishermen, and applications that include areas outside of the Southern California Bight. Exempted fishing permit data outside of the Southern California Bight is needed and National Marine Fisheries Service has workload issues.
