PROCESS FOR CONSIDERING ISSUES RELATED TO TRAWL ALLOCATION AND SOUTHERN SABLEFISH ATTAINMENT

Under Agenda Item H.2, the Council is scheduled to discuss a new ad hoc committee, tentatively identified as the Ad Hoc Trawl Allocation and Southern Sablefish Attainment Committee (TASSAC).

The Council intends to set out a process for work to be conducted by the committee. Staff has developed the following draft calendar for Council consideration. Note that the purpose of the May/June TASSAC webinar would be to identify information that might be developed to inform the committee's discussions, taking into account the limited amount of time available to produce the data/analysis.
