## HIGHLY MIGRATORY SPECIES ADVISORY SUBPANEL REPORT ON DEEP-SET BUOY GEAR AUTHORIZATION – RANGE OF ALTERNATIVES AND LIMITED ENTRY CRITERIA

- 1. The Highly Migratory Species Advisory Subpanel (HMSAS) recommends Alternative 2 as described in section 3.0 (Alternatives) in Agenda Item J.4.a Highly migratory Species Management Team (HMSMT) Report with limited entry in the Southern California Bight.
- 2. Number of limited entry permits to be issued (fishing capacity): After the initial issue of permits (approximately 50-60 as noted below) the HMSAS recommends not more than 25 limited entry permits be issued in the second year, if warranted.
- 3. **Qualifications to obtain a limited entry permit:** The HMSAS recommends in the first year DSBG limited entry permits be issued to active DGN and active EFP fishermen (an estimated 50-60 permits).
- 4. If additional permits are to be issued beyond the first year, the HMSAS recommends following Alternative 2, Option 2 as described in Agenda Item J.4.a, Supplemental HMSMT Report 2, but with the HMSAS modified tier rankings reordered as shown below.



Season is April 1 - March 31 of the following year.

Active drift gillnet permits are preliminarily defined as a minimum of one landing with DGN gear during the 2013/14-2017/18 seasons.
