a/ Inseason estimates are preliminary.

b/ Non-Indian coho fisheries are mark-selective prior to Sept., and non-mark-selective recreational fisheries occur in Sept., (except NOF) see the regulations for details.

c/ Effort is reported as landings. Chinook summer quota increased by adding spring quota rollover on an impact neutral basis. Total allowable catch is 40,000 Chinook for Treaty Indian fisheries in 2018.

d/ Numbers shown as Chinook quotas for non-Indian troll and rec. fisheries NOF are guidelines not quotas; only the total Chinook allowable catch is a quota.

e/ NOF non-Indian troll coho quota may be adjusted from preseason due to impact neutral transfer to recreational fishery. The preseason total Chinook quota was 27,500, and the preseason quota for coho was 5,600.

f/ Commercial troll monthly Chinook quotas may be transferred inseason on an impact neutral basis to the next opening period. In the Oregon KMZ, the Chinook preseason quotas were 1,500 in June, 2,000 in July and 500 in August. In the California KMZ, the Chinook preseason quotas were 3,600 in May, 4,000 in June, 4,000 in July and 4,000 in August.

g/ NOF recreational quotas may be adjusted from preseason due to impact neutral transfers between areas and from the NOF non-Indian troll fishery. The preseason coho quotas were: U.S./Canada Border to Cape Alava- 4,370 coho; Cape Alava to Queets River - 1,090 coho; Queets River to Leadbetter Point - 15,540 coho; Leadbetter Point to Cape Falcon - 21,000 coho. The preseason total Chinook quota was 27,500.

h/ Cape Falcon to Humbug Mt. recreational coho quota for September may be adjusted from preseason due to an impact neutral transfer from the recreational (mark-selective) coho quota for June 30-September 3. The preseason quota for September was 3,500 non marked coho.
