COASTAL PELAGIC SPECIES MANAGEMENT TEAM REPORT ON CENTRAL SUBPOPULATION OF NORTHERN ANCHOVY LITIGATION RESPONSE

The Coastal Pelagic Species Management Team (CPSMT) reviewed the April 2019 proposed rule (Agenda Item E.5, Supplemental Attachment 3) from the National Marine Fisheries Service for setting a revised overfishing limit (OFL), acceptable biological catch (ABC), and annual catch limit (ACL) for the Central Subpopulation of Northern Anchovy. The CPSMT sees the proposed rule as a viable replacement to the vacated OFL, ABC, and ACL. The proposed rule maintains a substantial buffer that should prevent overfishing. Therefore, the rule could remain in place until the Council has better information that merits a revision of these reference points.
