






### **US Coast Guard assessment 2018**








### 1993-2018 HSDN Sightings/ Seizures









January 2018



An 82' F/V targeting hagfish sank off Cape Alava, inside Olympic National Marine Sanctuary. Depsite dewatering efforts, the crew was forced to abandon the vessel and were recovered safely from the water.



## F/V Grounding

August 2018



A 56' fiberglass vessel with one person and a dog onboard ran aground off Santa Cruz in Monterey Bay National Marine Sanctuary. The operator and dog made it safely ashore with no injuries. The vessel broke up in surf and was a total loss.
