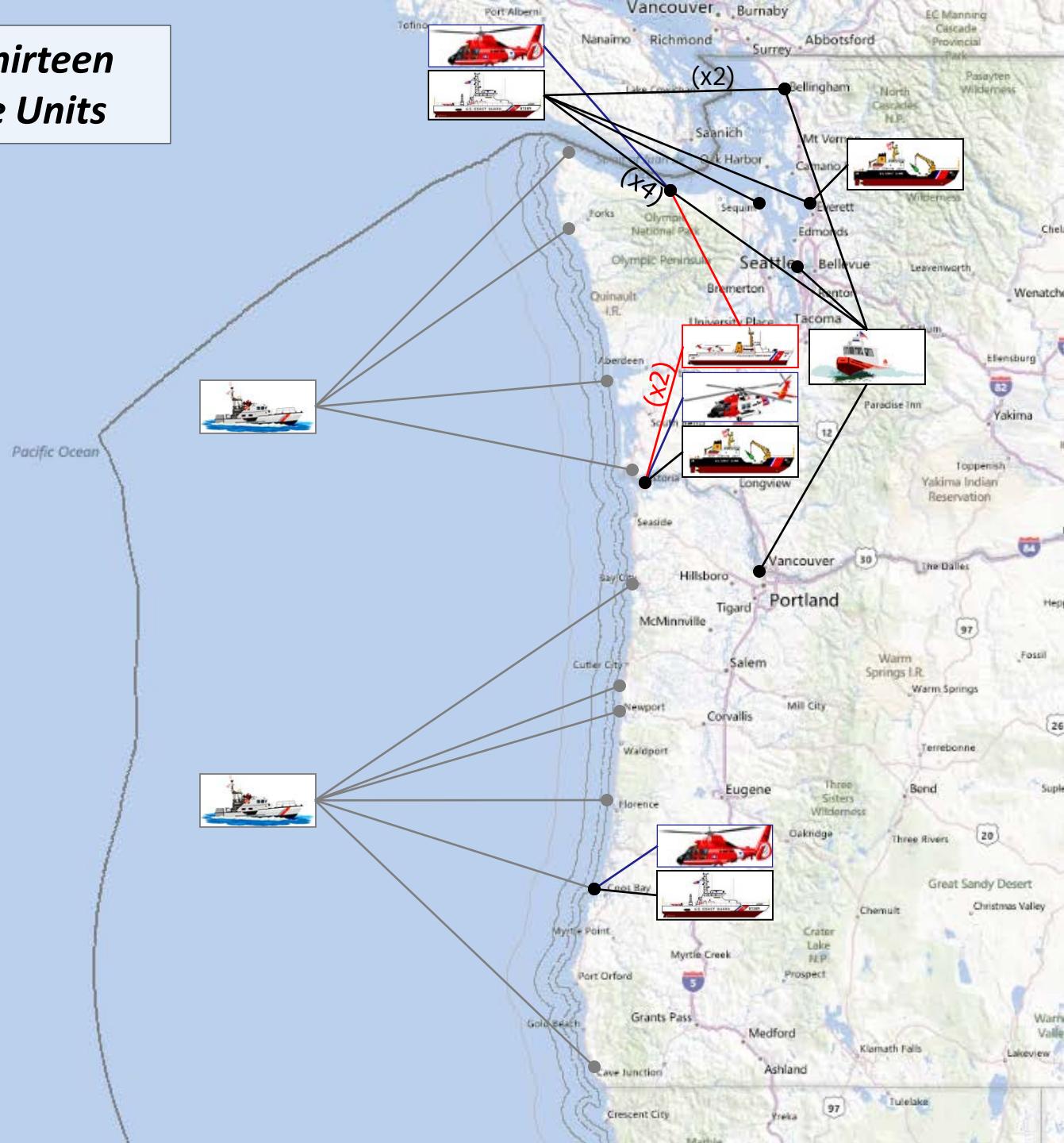

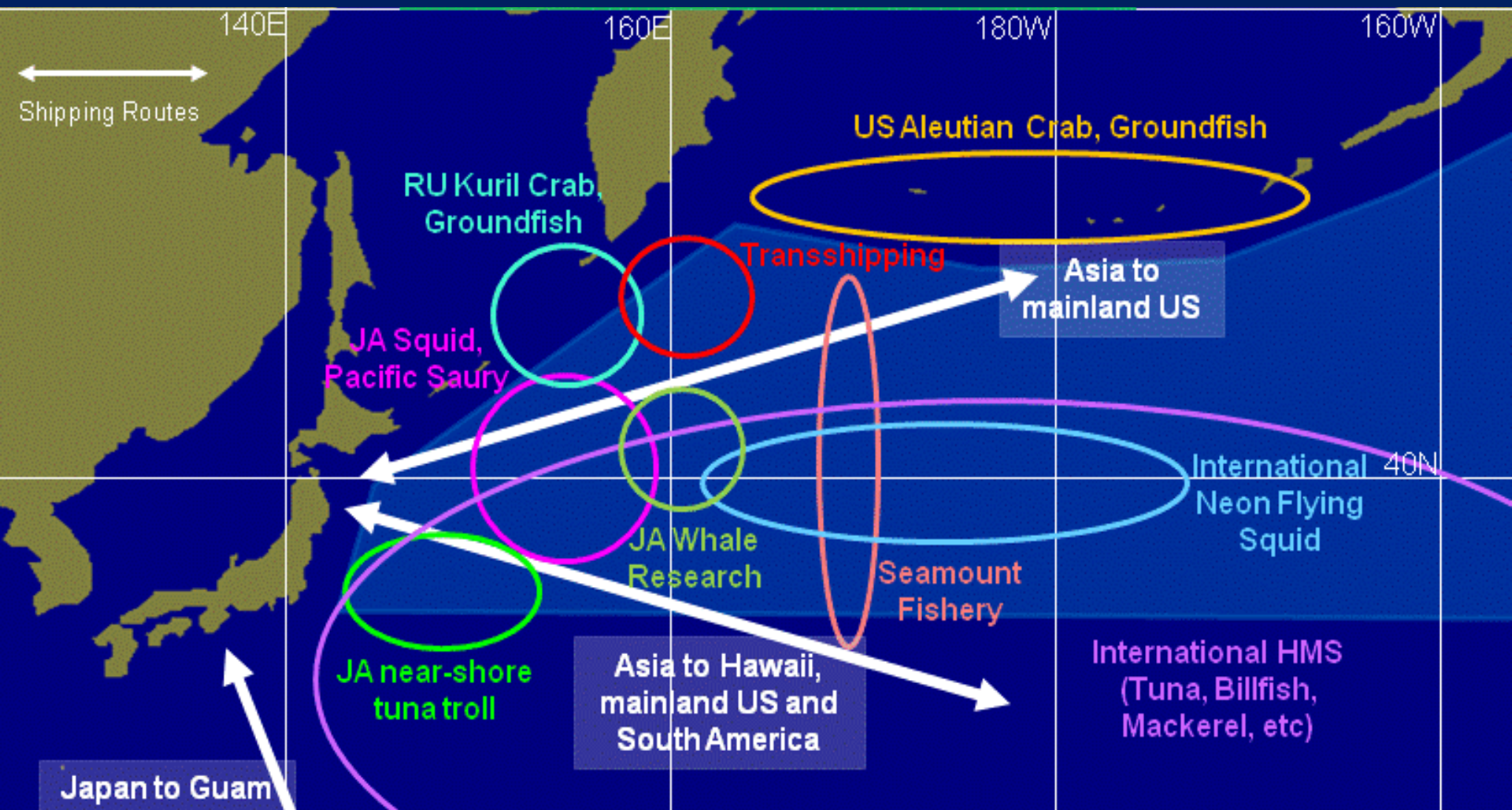


Operation North Pacific Guard May – Aug 2018



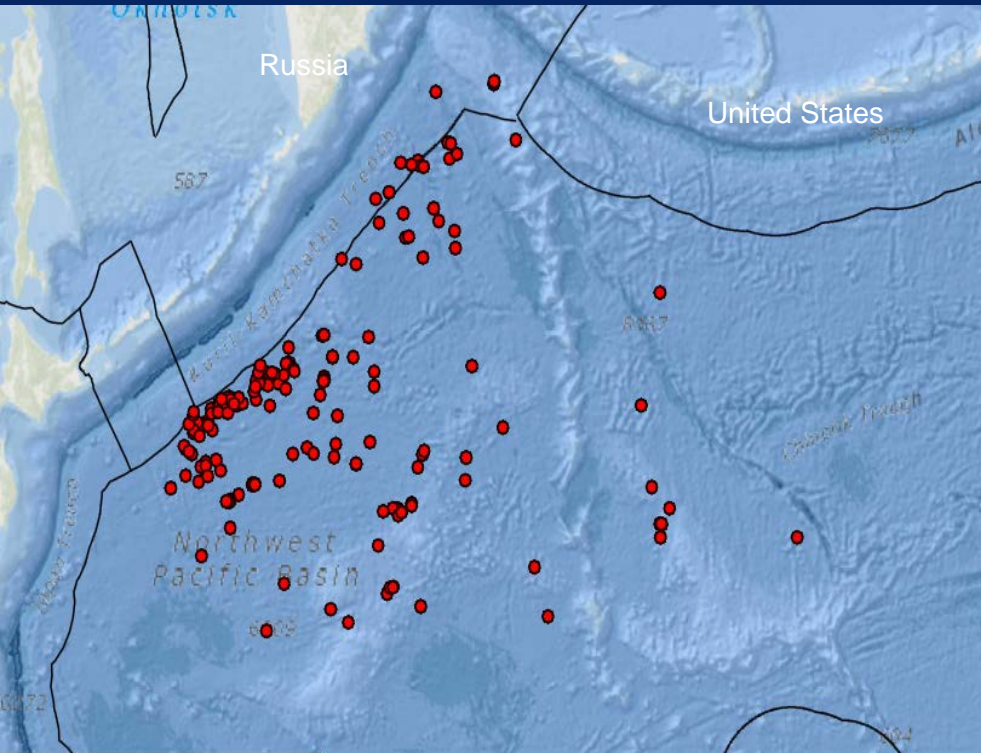


US Coast Guard assessment 2018



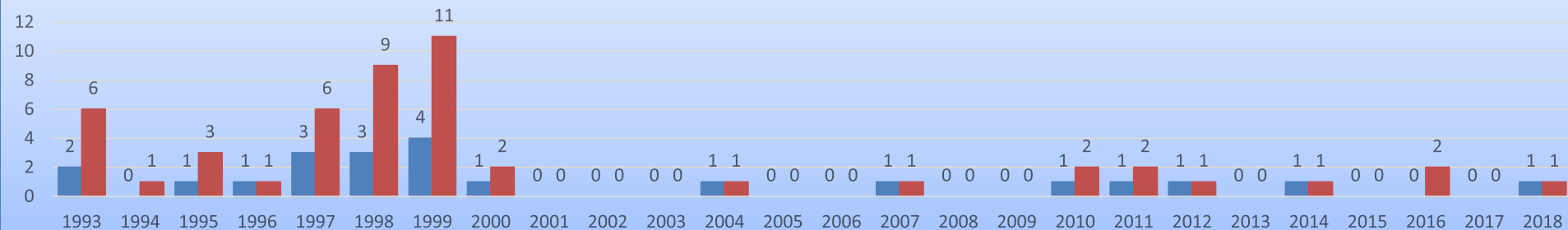


1993-2018 HSDN Sightings/ Seizures



HSDN Vessels

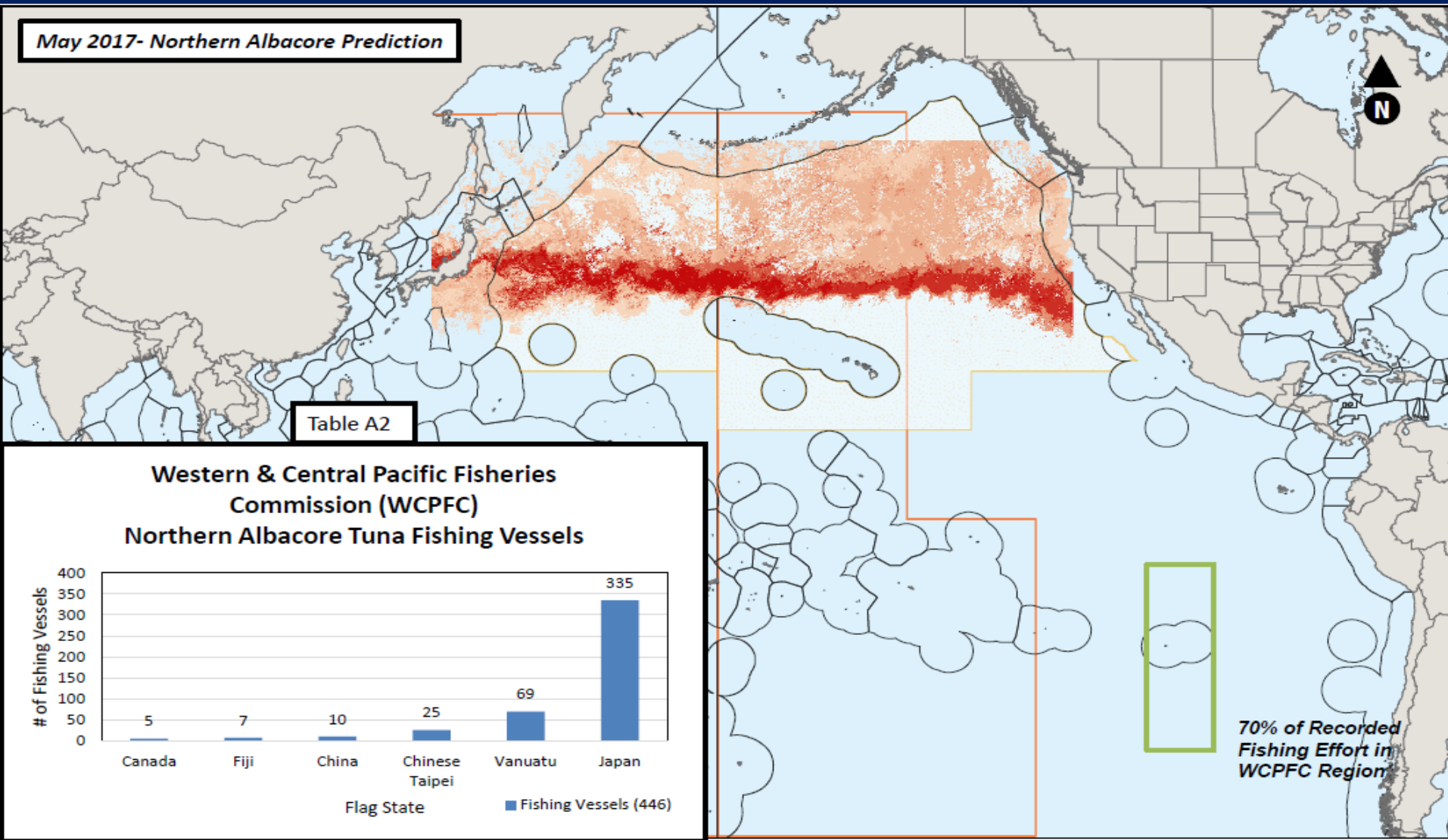

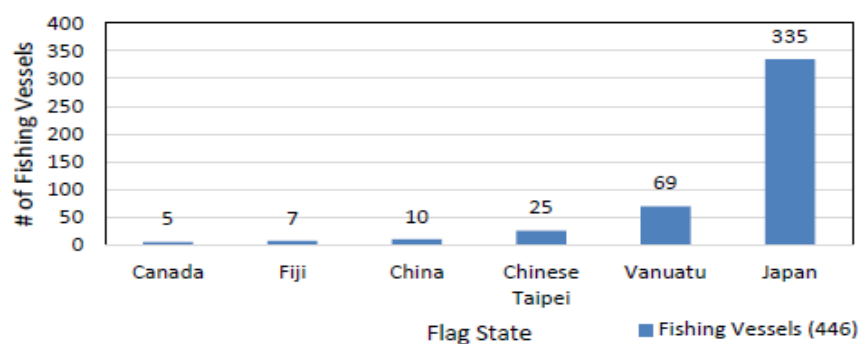


WCPFC vessels

Northern Albacore Tuna Fishing Vessels

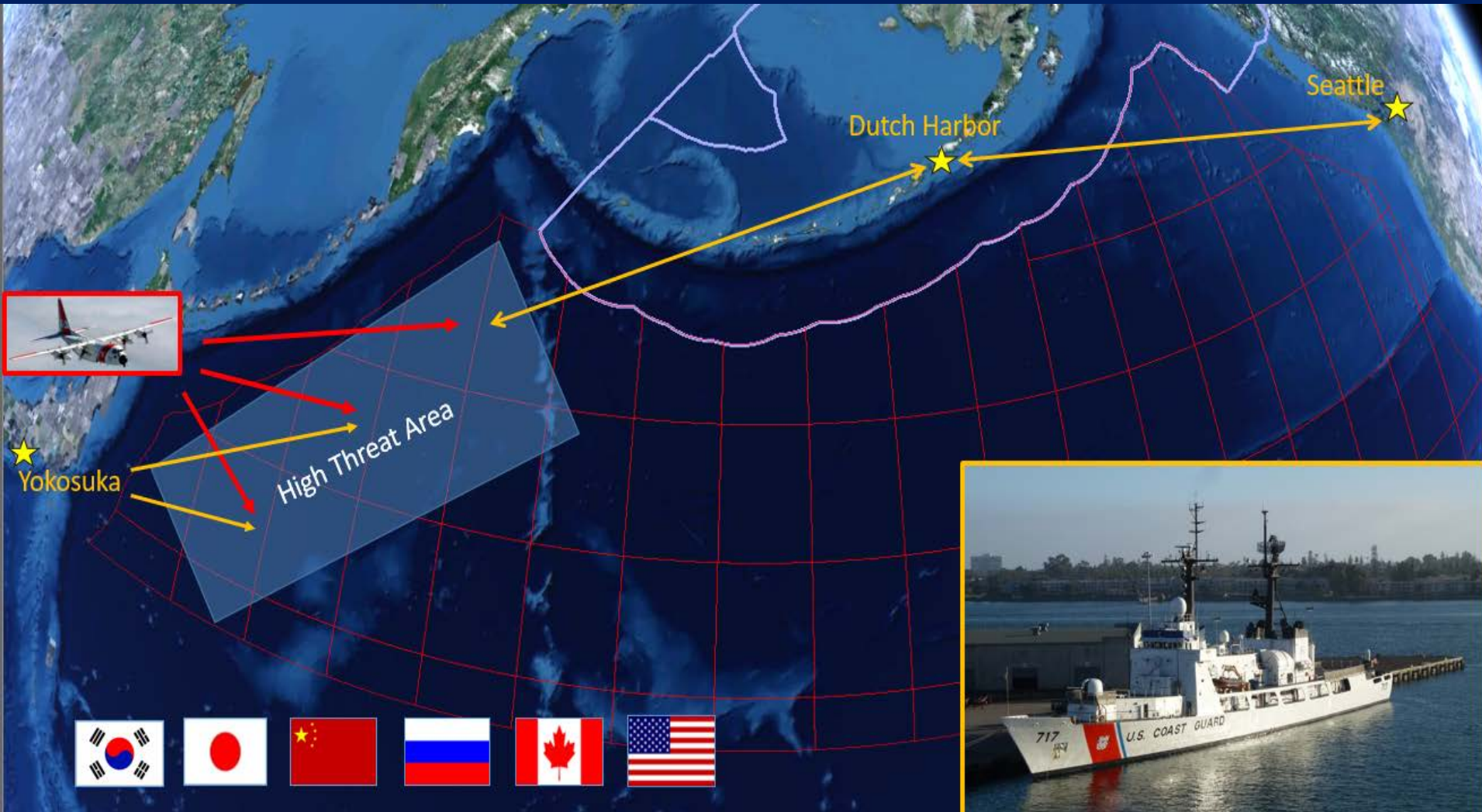

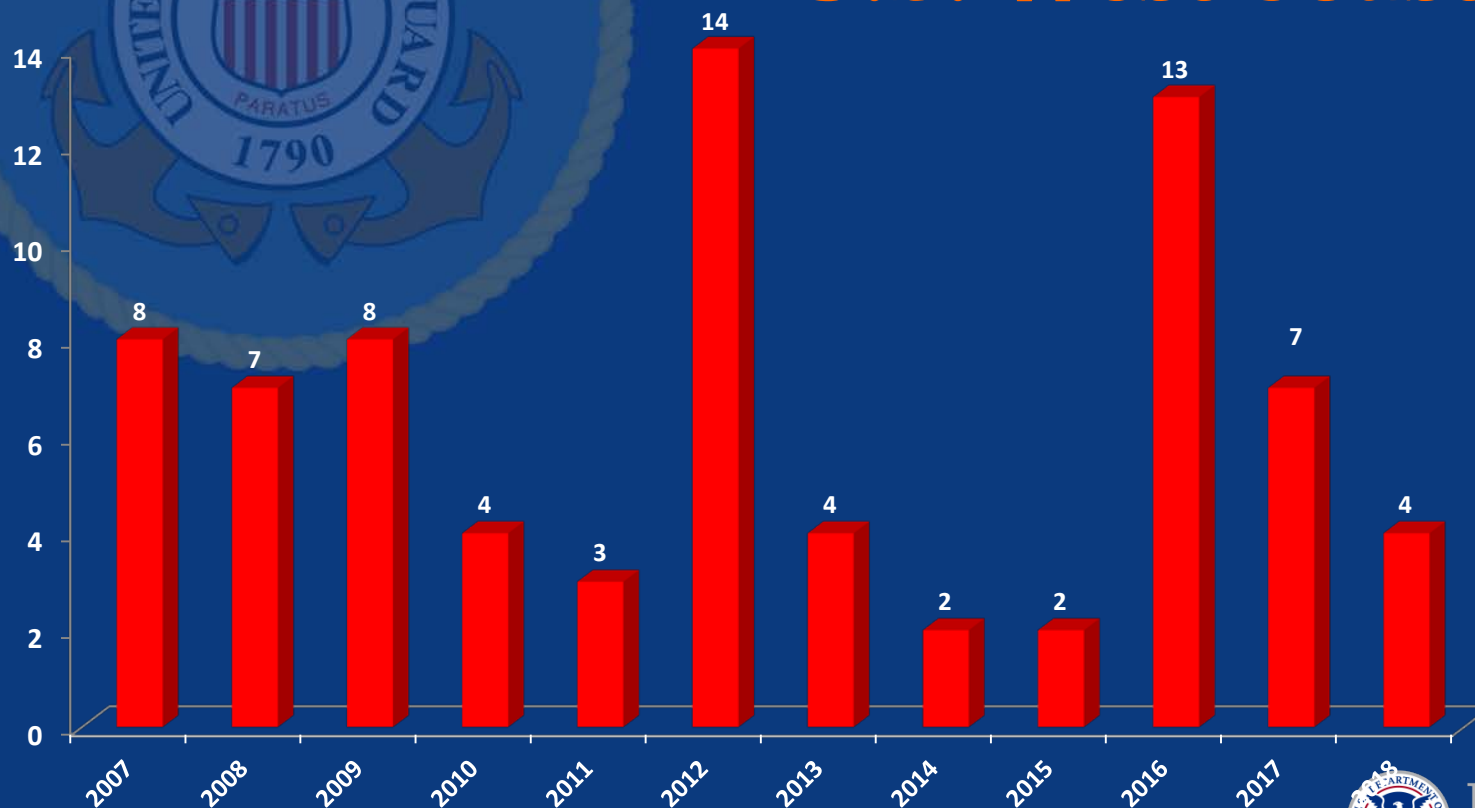

August 2018



A 56' fiberglass vessel with one person and a dog onboard ran aground off Santa Cruz in Monterey Bay National Marine Sanctuary. The operator and dog made it safely ashore with no injuries. The vessel broke up in surf and was a total loss.
