Active gear tending: Gear will be deployed in a manner that ensures it is actively tended and continuously monitored. Strike will be tended to as quickly as possible to aid in the quick an safe release of unmarketable or protected species.

Gear conflict/number of vessels: Our goal is to avoid over crowding a specific area and will be concentrating outside the 3nm from shore and between pt conception to Catalina. We expect few vessel interactions and gear conflict being outside the Channel Islands and Catalina are
