COP 19 - Biennial process hand-in-hand w/ SPEX

2. Steps

- a. Submit EFP apps for advance BB
- b. November 2019—Drafts approved for public review (incl set-asides)
- c. Proposals revised and made available for public review
- d. SSC/GMT/EC for detailed review (if requested by Council)
- e. June 2020—Council takes final action (incl set-asides)
- f. June/July 2020—Council forwards EFPs to NMFS for implementation
- g. November 2021—Interim/Preliminary reports due on 2021-2022 EFPs
- h. September 2023—Final reports due on 2021-2022 EFPs
