## FISHERY ECOSYSTEM PLAN (FEP) FIVE-YEAR REVIEW – FINAL ACTION

In September 2018, the Pacific Fishery Management Council (Council) initiated a review of the Council's Pacific Coast Fishery Ecosystem Plan (FEP). The initial focus of this update has been a revision of the FEP Vision (including purpose, goals, and objectives). In September 2019, the Council adopted revised chapters 1 and 2 for public review (Attachment 1), which include a vision statement, goals and objectives, and other reorganized elements in these chapters from the current FEP. This review draft was posted to the Council's website shortly after the September 2019 meeting to give other advisory bodies and the public a chance to review it well in advance of this meeting. Considering any additional comments from advisory bodies, the Council will adopt the revised chapters at this meeting.

The Council directed its Ecosystem Workgroup (EWG) to submit a proposed outline for the revision of the remaining chapters of the FEP for it to review at this meeting. The EWG will submit proposed changes in a supplemental report. The Council may provide guidance for the EWG's future work on these chapters.
