NATIONAL MARINE FISHERIES SERVICE REPORT ON EXEMPTED FISHING PERMIT

The National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS) is providing this report to update the Pacific Fishery Management Council on the 2020 trawl gear exempted fishing permit (EFP).

2020 Trawl Gear EFP

The 2020 Trawl Gear EFP began on January 1 of this year. NMFS held an open enrollment period from November 26 through December 6, 2019. A total of 45 vessels registered for the 2020 Trawl Gear EFP and 41 of 45 permits have been issued. The remaining four vessels do not meet EFP eligibility requirements at this time.

As of February 18, 3 vessels have participated in the Trawl Gear EFP during the 2020 fishing year. These vessels have caught 4 Chinook salmon, no eulachon, sturgeon, or Coho salmon, and approximately 1.2 million pounds of groundfish, totaling approximately \$468,400 in revenue. All 4 Chinook salmon were caught north of 42° North latitude (See Table 1).
