

Agenda Item F.2 Incidental Catch Recommendations: Options for the Salmon Troll and Final Recommendations For Fixed Gear Sablefish Fisheries

Council Action:

- Recommend inseason changes to April 2020 (pre-May 1 fisheries) retention limits in the salmon troll fishery, as necessary.
- Adopt for public review a range of options for halibut landing restrictions in the 2020 salmon troll fishery beginning May 1, and for April 1-30, 2021.
- Adopt final halibut landing restrictions for the fixed gear sablefish fishery north of Point Chehalis from April 1 to October 31, 2020.
