

INSEASON ADJUSTMENTS – FINAL ACTION

Management measures for groundfish are set by the Council with the general understanding that these measures will likely need to be modified within the biennium to attain, but not exceed, the annual catch limits (ACL). This agenda item will consider progress to date of the 2020 groundfish fisheries. The Council has the opportunity to recommend adjustments to current routine management measures, such as trip limits, necessary to achieve conservation objectives.

Shorebased Individual Fishing Quota (IFQ) Surplus Carryover

At their March meetings, the Council typically provides recommendations to National Marine Fisheries Service regarding the issuance of the prior year surplus carryover quota pounds into the current year's shorebased IFQ program. This action was unable to be completed at the March or April 2020 meetings due to unforeseen circumstances. As such, this item will need to be addressed at a future time.

Council Action:

Consider projections for the 2020 fisheries and adopt inseason adjustments, as necessary.
