CORRECTIONS TO TABLES IN AGENDA ITEM G.6, ATTACHMENT 2

Review of <u>G.6 Attachment 2, 2021-2022 Management Measures Analytical Document, April 2020</u> revealed a few errors in tables. It is important to note, these tables were developed after the analyses were completed and were not part of any calculation. These tables will be corrected and provided to the Council for their final review in June 2020. The errors are as follows:

Chapter 2.1 Deductions from the ACL

In Tables 2-9 through 2-12 the cabezon/kelp greenling complex ACLs, off-the-top deductions, and harvest guideline values for Washington and Oregon were transposed. The following page (page 2) shows the corrected table entries.

Chapter 2.5.2.6 Non-sablefish south of 40° 10' N. lat. Allocations and Trip Limits for No Action

An error in Table 2-60 was noted in the row that starts with LEFG 2 South of 34° 27' N. lat The trip limit should read "5,000 lbs. / 2 months, of which no more than 3,000 lbs. may be vermilion" instead of "8,000 lbs. / 2 months, of which no more than 3,000 lbs. may be vermilion." The corrected table is shown on page 3.

Chapter 3.2 Allocating the Fishery HG

An error in Table 3-4 was noted in the petrale sole allocation row for 2022. The correct harvest guideline amount for 2022 should be 3,067.5 mt, with subsequent allocations to trawl as 2,914.1 mt and non-trawl as 153.4 mt. The corrected row is shown below on page 4.

Chapter 3.5.1 Limited Entry and Open Access Fixed Gear – Alternative 1

In table 3-12, the shortbelly rockfish and petrale sole values were transposed. The corrected table values are shown below on page 4.
