SOUTHERN OREGON/NORTHERN CALIFORNIA COAST COHO AD HOC WORKGROUP REPORT

The Southern Oregon/Northern California Coast (SONCC) Coho Ad-Hoc Workgroup conducted their first meeting on June 9, 2020. The roster for this Workgroup is complete, and consists of tribal, Federal, and state representatives as well as an independent contractor. At this meeting, the Workgroup completed the administrative tasks of electing a Chair and Vice Chair (Table 1) and approved a tentative meeting schedule (Table 2).

The Workgroup also finalized the Terms of Reference (TOR) which was drafted by National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS) and provided to the Workgroup by the Pacific Fishery Management Council (Council). The Workgroup has provided an updated draft of the TOR and recommends Council adoption (Agenda Item E.1.a, Supplemental Workgroup Report 2). Clarifying edits plus adjustments to the timeline encompass the majority of the changes to the TOR.

The Workgroup is scheduled to meet again in August to continue data compilation and analysis and prepare a draft outline for a risk assessment.
