

LEGISLATIVE MATTERS

The Legislative Committee (LC) will meet on Tuesday, September 8 to review bills proposed in the 116th Congress (Agenda Item C.3, Attachment 1).

The Council received a request to discuss the RESTAURANTS Act (S. 4012/H.R. 7197), introduced by Senator Roger Wicker (R-MS) and Representative Earl Blumenauer (D-OR), respectively. The bill would establish a \$120 billion revitalization fund to help independent restaurants deal with the long-term structural challenges facing the industry because of COVID-19, and to support the reemployment of 11 million workers.
