Pacific Fishery Management Council to Hold Webinar Only Meeting in November 2020 to Adopt Management Measures for Ocean Fisheries

The Pacific Fishery Management Council (PFMC or Council) and its advisory bodies will meet November 9-10, 12-13 and 16-20, 2020 by **webinar only**, to address issues related to groundfish, Pacific halibut, salmon, highly migratory species, coastal pelagic species, and administrative matters.

Key agenda items for the meeting include Council considerations to:

- Continue the Biennial Highly Migratory Species Harvest Specifications and Management Measures Process by Adopting Available Stock Status Determination Criteria and Considering the Need to Develop Other Harvest Objectives and/or Management Measures
- Revisit Hard Caps on Bycatch in the Drift Gillnet Fishery with a Review of a NMFS Report on the Response to Comments in the Final Rule and a Range of Viable Rulemaking Measures for Council Consideration
- Adopt Pacific Whiting Yield Set-Asides for 2021 and Final Action on Groundfish Fishery Inseason Adjustments.
- Adopt a Range of Alternatives for Gear Switching for Sablefish in the Groundfish Trawl Catch Share Fishery
- Adopt a Final Salmon Preseason Management Schedule for 2021 Fisheries
- Adopt Final Alternatives for Southern Resident Killer Whale Endangered Species Act (ESA) Consultation
- Review the Risk Assessment and Discuss the Development of Alternatives for the Southern Oregon/Northern California Coast Coho ESA Consultation
- Adopt Final Pacific Halibut 2021 Catch Sharing Plan Changes and Recommendations for 2021 Directed Commercial Fishery Regulation Changes
- Adopt a Final Alternative for the Transition of Pacific Halibut Management from IPHC to NMFS and PFMC
- Adopt Preliminary Recommendations for Coastal Pelagic Species 2021 Exempted Fishing Permits and Methodology Reviews

Meeting Arrangements

The meeting of the Council and its advisory entities was originally planned to be held in person, but due to concerns over the COVID-19 pandemic, the format of the meetings have been changed to be conducted only by webinars.

There will be no meetings schedule during the weekend of November 14-15, however, the meeting will continue daily on Monday, November 16 at 8 a.m. through Friday, November 20, 2020. Broadcasts end daily at 5 p.m. *or when business for the day is complete*. Only the audio portion and presentations displayed on the screen will be broadcast. The audio portion for the public is listen-only except that an opportunity for oral public comment will be provided prior to Council Action on each agenda item. Meetings of advisory bodies will also be conducted by webinar based on the schedules in the attached agenda. There will be one opportunity for public comment daily in each of the webinars. The advance briefing materials will be available for review on the Council website no later than Friday, October 23, 2020, and supplemental materials will be posted as they are received and reviewed.
