

**COASTAL PELAGIC SPECIES MANAGEMENT TEAM REPORT ON STANDARDIZED  
 BYCATCH REPORTING METHODOLOGY**

The Coastal Pelagic Species Management Team (CPSMT) received a briefing from Mr. Brett Wiedoff on the final rule for standardized bycatch reporting methodology that Regional Fishery Management Councils around the nation were asked to review, to determine whether each Fishery Management Plan (FMP) under the Council purview conforms to the rule. The CPSMT completed a preliminary review of the CPS FMP and the Stock Assessment and Fishery Evaluation (SAFE) report and filled out the table accordingly. Due to the general similarities in gear, fishing practices and bycatch, reporting for CPS fisheries primarily falls within one fishing sector, with some spatial separation.
