Agenda Item G.3 Inseason Adjustments for 2020 and 2021 Including Pacific Whiting Set-Asides for 2021-- Final Action

## **Council Action:**

- Adopt final inseason adjustments for 2020 and 2021 as necessary, to achieve, but not exceed, annual catch limits and other management objectives.
- 2. Adopt Pacific whiting yield set-asides for 2021.

## CDFW Motion, G.3 Inseason:

I move the Council adopt the following recommendations, as described in Agenda Item G.3., Supplemental GMT Report 1:

- 1. Set the Pacific whiting set-aside for research activities and the pink shrimp fishery at the GAP-recommended 750 mt for 2021
- 2. For sablefish DTL in 2021:
  - a. Adopt Option 1 for Open Access North of 36° N. lat. 600 lbs. / day, or 1 landing per week of up to 2,000 lbs., not to exceed 4,000 lbs /2 months (no action needed for Limited Entry North)
  - b. Adopt Option 1 for Limited Entry South of 36° N. lat. 2,500 lbs per week, and for Open Access South at 2,000 lbs. per week, not to exceed 6,000 lbs. / 2 months
- 3. Adopt Option 1 for both LEFG and OA trip limits for lingcod south of 40° 10′ N. lat in 2021: LEFG at 1,600 lbs. / 2 months, and OA at 700 lbs. / month.
- 4. Adopt Option 1 for OA shortspine and longspine thornyhead south of 34° 27′ N. lat. in 2021: daily trip limit of 100 lbs. / day and not more than 1,000 lbs. / 2 months.
