

COUNCIL COORDINATION COMMITTEE MEETING REPORT

The 2021 Council Coordination Committee (CCC) spring meeting was hosted via webinar by the National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS) and the Pacific Fishery Management Council (Pacific Council or Council), on May 18-20, 2021. The meeting agenda is shown in Agenda Item C.1, Attachment 1. Chair, Mr. Marc Gorelnik; Vice-Chair, Mr. Brad Pettinger; Executive Director, Mr. Chuck Tracy; and Deputy Director, Mr. Mike Burner attended on behalf of the Council, and Mr. Ryan Wulff represented NMFS West Coast Region.

The CCC discussed a number of issues of national importance, including Executive Orders 13921 and 14008, offshore wind development, a draft procedural directive on applying information law to electronic monitoring data, National Standard 1 Draft Technical Memorandum on managing with annual catch limits for data-limited stocks, integration of Magnuson-Stevens Fishery Conservation and Management Act (MSA) and Endangered Species Act, and a new rule on Council member financial disclosure and recusal. Attachment 2 provides some additional details on issues potentially relevant to Pacific Council workload and assignments.

The next meeting of the Council Coordination Committee (CCC) is planned for October 19-21, 2021 and will be hosted, in person, by the Pacific Council at the: Portola Hotel and Spa, 2 Portola Plaza, in Monterey, California.
