## Pacific Fishery Management Council to Re-Consider the Harvest Control Rule for Southern Oregon/Northern California Coast Coho

The Pacific Fishery Management Council (Council) will meet by webinar on January 21, 2022 at 8 a.m. to reconsider the November 2021 motion regarding the Harvest Control Rule for Southern Oregon/Northern California Coast (SONCC) coho. The meeting will end when business for the day is complete.

This Emergency Council Meeting will be limited to a single agenda item, which includes the Harvest Control Rule for SONCC coho and related amendments to the Council's Salmon Fishery Management Plan.

#### **Meeting Access and Arrangements**

This Emergency Council Meeting will be held by webinar and is open to the public. The broadcast will begin at 8 a.m. Pacific Standard Time (PST) Friday, January 21, 2022. The meeting is scheduled to continue through 12 p.m. January 21<sup>st</sup> or when business for the day is complete. The audio portion for the public is listen-only except that an opportunity for oral public comment will be provided prior to Council Action. It is recommended that you use a computer headset to listen to the meeting, but you may use your telephone for the audio-only portion of the meeting.

A meeting of the Salmon Advisory Subpanel will also be conducted by webinar on Thursday, January 20, 2022. Instructions for how to connect to this webinar will be posted on the Council's January 2022 Meeting webpage prior to the first day of the meeting.
