LEGISLATIVE MATTERS

The Legislative Committee (LC) will meet on Tuesday, March 8, to review bills proposed in the 117th Congress (Agenda Item C.4, Attachment 1).

A hearing by the House Natural Resources Committee's Subcommittee on Water, Oceans, and Wildlife on two bills to reauthorize the Magnuson-Stevens Fishery Conservation and Management Act (MSA) H.R. 4690 - Sustaining America's Fisheries for the Future Act introduced by Representative Huffman, H.R. 59 Strengthening Fishing Communities and Increasing Flexibility in Fisheries Management Act introduced by Representative Young, and H.R. 5770 the Forage Fish Conservation Act of 2021 introduced by Representative Dingell was held November 16, 2021. Ms. Janet Coit, Assistant Administrator, National Marine Fisheries Service and Chair Marc Gorelnik provided testimony as a panel of administrative and government experts.

The LC will discuss pertinent newly introduced bills, the status of existing bills, and hear a report on the MSA reauthorization hearings, and provide recommendations.
