HABITAT ISSUES

The Habitat Committee (HC) will meet on Tuesday and Wednesday, March 8 - 9, 2022, to discuss Marine Planning, Ecosystem matters, Klamath dam removal, and other habitat-related topics.

At its November 2021 meeting, the Pacific Fishery Management Council (Council) directed the HC to track the Nordic Aquafarms Environmental Impact Review (EIR) and prepare a letter for Council consideration once the EIR becomes available. The EIR was released in December 2021, with a comment period that closed on February 18, 2022. The HC drafted a letter for Council consideration under the quick response procedure, and the Council response was not available at the time of the advance Briefing Book.
