## HABITAT ISSUES

The Habitat Committee (HC) will meet on Thursday and Friday, April 7-8, 2022, to discuss Klamath Dam Removal, the Groundfish Non-Trawl Rockfish Conservation Area, and Central Valley Chinook. The HC will also receive a briefing from the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration's (NOAA) Deep Sea Coral Research and Technology Program Marine Planning.

At its March 2022 meeting, the HC notified the Pacific Fishery Management Council (Council) that they intend to develop a proposed comment letter on the Klamath Dam Removal Notice of Intent to develop an Environmental Impact Statement. That letter is expected to be available in supplemental April Briefing Book materials.
