1. Recommend inseason changes to halibut landing restrictions in the salmon troll fishery during April 1-May 15, 2022, as necessary.
2. Adopt for public review a range of options for halibut landing restrictions in the salmon troll fishery beginning May 16, 2022, and for April 1-May 15, 2023.
3. Adopt final halibut landing restrictions for the fixed gear sablefish fishery north of Point Chehalis for the 2022 season beginning April 1.
