

ANNUAL U.S. COAST GUARD WEST COAST FISHERY ENFORCEMENT REPORT

The U.S. Coast Guard (USCG) will present an annual report covering its West Coast fishery enforcement and fishing vessel safety monitoring efforts for the past year, including enforcement hours, boarding, and detected violations (Agenda Item I.1.a, USCG Report 1).
