




Summer 2021 CCE Survey

- FSV Reuben Lasker
- 86 Days at Sea
- 4 Legs, 3.5 Months
- Legs I-III: VI-San Diego
- FV Lisa Marie off WA, OR, & N. CA
- FV Long Beach Carnage off C. and S. CA
- 5 Saildrones in anchovy areas
- Leg IV: to Pt. Eugenia
 Southern Stock Sardine
 Mexico Collaboration





2021 Summer CCE Survey










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- Parallel systematic design
- The core area spanned from Cape Flattery to mid-northern Baja California (to approximately El Rosario).
- 107 east-west transects totaling 5,804 nmi, and conducted 124 Nordic trawls.
- The nearshore spanned from Cape Flattery to San Diego, including around Santa Cruz and Santa Catalina Islands, and was surveyed by Long Beach Carnage and Lisa Marie. A total of 254 east-west transects and 58 purse seine sets were completed.
- Seven Mexican researchers participated on three survey legs.






NOAA FISHERIES


- Anchovy dominated the core region in the south.
- Jack mackerel dominated the core region in the north.
- Sardine had two focuses of distribution: WA/OR and Southern CA/Baja.
- Sardine and Pacific mackerel comprise a small fraction of the CPS.
- Pyrosomes were a problem in some areas.
- Only samples north of the US border are presented here.
- Technical reports for survey not ready yet.

Survey updates

Winter CalCOFI

Cancelled due to Covid-19 issues.

Spring CalCOFI

- Scheduled for April 6-28, 2022 aboard FSV Shimada.
- Total of 104 stations from San Diego to San Francisco, out 350 miles.

2022 Spring CPS

 No survey planned due to Continuing Resolution and delayed Federal budget.

Summer CalCOFI

 Scheduled for July 10-25, 2022, aboard RV Bold Horizon.






2022 California Current Ecosystem Survey

- FSV Reuben Lasker
- Current plan is for 76 Days at Sea, 6/27 to 9/23/2022, 4 legs.
- Northern Vancouver Island to Pt Eugenia Mexico.
- No Saildones in 2022 to fill-in adaptive sampling areas.
- Nearshore sampling of entire US coast by Long Beach Carnage and Lisa Marie.
- Sampling in Mexican waters from Border to Pt. Eugenia planned, permits have been submitted.
- Unclear if the Mexican RV Fraser/Carranza will be able to continue south to cover the rest of Baja California.









2022 West Coast Pelagic Surveys Re-envisioning

By 2025 and beyond, NMFS is attempting to combine NWFSC and SWFSC west coast surveys of hake and coastal pelagic species.

- An "integrated survey" will support the NMFS mission of optimizing the investment of federal funds by improving the data collected for stock assessments, management strategy evaluations, and ecosystem research and modeling, while advancing NOAA strategic priorities for Uncrewed Systems (UxS), Strategic Application of Transformational Tools ('omics, e.g. eDNA) and the development and implementation of Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning tools (AI/ML).
- Building upon joint survey efforts in the past and collaborating on innovative technologies and survey approaches to conduct an integrated survey in 2025.
 We have identified project managers for 2022 and will conduct a Stakeholder Science-Management Workshop in Fall 2022.




