-My vessel Salt and Light is based out of Newport Harbor, Newport Beach, California. It's a smaller fishing vessel with limited working deck space. Standard set buoy gear is perfect for this vessel to work 5 sets of gear and actively tending in close proximity to vessel traffic and mammal migration. We plan to fish off Orange County coastline and fish up to 32 days.

- -Active gear tending: We will have all our gear set in formation depending on current and conditions. Visual distance at all times, radar reflectors on high flyer buoys. Strobe lights on all high flyers
- -Gear conflicts/number of vessels: Depending on vessel traffic we will be able to deploy less gear in the water.
- -Gear configuration: We will be using the standard deep set buoy gear as described in attachment A.
- -Concurrent gear use: A detection buoy followed by a hard ball, followed by a 49 pound buoy, followed by high flyer locator flag with radar reflector and strobe light.

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


# DSBG Amendment Request to Fish within 3 Miles of Southern California Coast

I've been an elder in the commercial swordfish fishery since 1973 fishing based out of Newport Beach, California fishing locally and offshore islands. I'm familiar with the local harpoon fishery in Dana Point and Catalina Island. My vessel is licensed to harpoon fish and we deep drop rod and reel 1-3 miles off the beach in the Southern California Bright.

The vessel "Salt and Light" is a small Costa Mesa built fiberglass sport fisher. My intentions for the amendment request is for the privilege of gathering much needed research data for the management council.

The chart enclosed shows area of request to fish in state waters within 3 miles, the Orange County coastline 5 sets of DSBG maximum. Gear configuration bottom hook above sea floor 200 feet minimum.
