INSEASON ADJUSTMENTS - FINAL ACTION

Under this agenda item, the Pacific Fishery Management Council (Council) is scheduled to review the progress of groundfish fisheries to-date and consider adopting inseason adjustments, such as trip limit adjustments and season structure, as appropriate. The management measures for groundfish are set by the Council with the general understanding that these measures may need to be adjusted within the biennium to attain, but not exceed, the annual catch limits. Adjustments are, in part, based on recent landings data and the latest information from the West Coast Groundfish Observer Program. The Groundfish Management Team (GMT) and the Groundfish Advisory Subpanel (GAP) are expected to provide reports to the Council under this agenda item.

Council Action:

Consider projections for the 2022 Fisheries and Adopt Final Inseason Adjustments as Necessary to Achieve but Not Exceed Annual Catch Limits and Other Management Objectives.
