

TRAWL CATCH SHARE PROGRAM AND INTER-SECTOR ALLOCATION REVIEW - HEARING SCHEDULE

At its September 2022 meeting, the Council initiated its process for review of the trawl catch share program (required at least once every seven years) and the intersector allocations specified for review by [COP 27](#) (see Agenda Item H.2, Attachment 1 for a list). The Council also directed that:

- draft review documents be developed by updating key information contained in the 2017 reviews; and
- public hearings on the reviews be held in the spring of 2023.

Under this agenda item, the Council is scheduled to adopt a schedule and locations for those hearings. Staff has provided an initial hearings proposal for Council consideration (Agenda Item H.2, Attachment 1). At its June 2023 meeting, the Council will use the updated analytical documents and hearings as one basis for determining the scope of the reviews and determine steps to take in moving through and finalizing the review process.

Council Action:

Adopt 2023 public hearings schedule and locations.
