ANNUAL INTERNATIONAL PACIFIC HALIBUT COMMISSION MEETING REPORT

The 2023 Annual Meeting of the International Pacific Halibut Commission (IPHC) was held in Victoria, British Columbia January 23-27, 2023. The meeting included reports on recent survey results and current stock status, consideration of the probabilities of risks and benefits involved with specific harvest choices, and discussions focused on harvest policy and methods for distributing coastwide yield to regulatory areas. The IPHC reached agreement for 2023 Pacific halibut catch limits, which include the Area 2A Total Catch Exploitable Yield (TCEY), and the resulting Fishery Catch Exploitable Yield (FCEY) described in Attachment 1.

Under this agenda item, Dr. Basia Hutniczak, Fisheries Policy Branch Manager for IPHC, will provide an overview of the Annual Meeting, stock assessment, and plans for upcoming stock assessment surveys. In addition, the national report from the United States submitted to the IPHC which includes harvest estimates for the 2022 season and the annual Enforcement Report for Area 2A is provided as Attachment 2 under this agenda item.

Mr. Phil Anderson, the Pacific Fishery Management Council's (Council's) representative to the IPHC, attended the Annual Meeting, along with numerous other interested parties from Area 2A. Mr. Anderson provided a brief summary of the discussions and results of the meeting for Council consideration (Agenda Item C.1.b, IPHC Representative Report 1).
