## RECOMMENDATIONS FOR 2023 MANAGEMENT ALTERNATIVE ANALYSIS

The Salmon Technical Team (STT) will present the Pacific Fishery Management Council (Council) with coordinated coastwide management alternatives which embody, to the extent possible, the management elements identified thus far by the Council. The Council may need to provide clarification to the STT on any questions that may arise and may need to provide direction to the STT for changes to the management alternatives presented under this agenda item. The STT will conduct a full analysis and provide the Council with the results.

Additional direction from the Council may be necessary as the management alternatives are developed. The STT will provide adjusted management alternatives based on Council guidance as this meeting progresses. It is anticipated that the Council will adopt for public review coastwide management alternatives prior to the conclusion of the 2023 March Council meeting.

## **Council Action**:

- 1. Provide clarification to the STT on any questions, as needed.
- 2. Provide direction on management alternative development and STT analysis, as needed.
- 3. Confirm management alternatives for STT analysis.
