APPOINT SALMON HEARINGS OFFICERS

In 2023, the Pacific Fishery Management Council (Council) has scheduled one public hearing for each coastal state (Agenda Item D.8, Attachment 1). The hearings are currently scheduled to be held in-person on Monday, March 20 in Westport, Washington; Monday, March 20 in North Bend (Coos Bay), Oregon; and Tuesday March 21 in Santa Rosa, California. Consistent with past salmon hearings that were held in-person, virtual participation or streaming will not be available. A summary of the verbal public comments heard at the hearings will be provided to the Pacific Fishery Management Council at its April meeting.

The public is also able to provide comments and recommendations on the alternatives prior to and during the April Council meeting. Public comment on the salmon management alternatives can be submitted in writing through the Pacific Council's e-portal (https://pfmc.psmfc.org). Verbal public comment will also be accepted at the April Council meeting.

The California Department of Fish and Wildlife, the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife, and the Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife also may announce additional state-sponsored hearings.
