The Habitat Committee (HC) will meet online April 1-2, 2023 to discuss topics on the Pacific Fishery Management Council's April meeting agenda. Topics will include coastal pelagic species essential fish habitat, Klamath and Sacramento River Chinook habitat indicators, the removal process for four Klamath River dams, and other items on the Council agenda.
