GROUNDFISH MANAGEMENT TEAM REPORT ON FUTURE COUNCIL MEETING AGENDA AND WORKLOAD PLANNING

The Groundfish Management Team (GMT) reviewed the draft Year-At-A-Glance (<u>YAG; Agenda</u> <u>Item G.6, Attachment 1, March 2023</u>) and the draft April agenda (<u>Agenda Item G.6, Attachment</u> <u>2, March 2023</u>) contained in the advanced briefing book, as well as the status of ongoing projects, and offers the following for consideration by the Pacific Fishery Management Council (Council).

In the past, the GMT has provided a GMT YAG that is specific to groundfish items and informed by our own workload and expectations as a team. Given that the timing of Gear Switching Preliminary Preferred Alternative/Final Preferred Alternative affects workload and timing associated with the Trawl Catch Shares and Inter-Sector Allocation Review, and the expectation that newly prioritized items under F.8 at this meeting will need to be agendized for future meetings, the GMT will provide an updated GMT YAG at a later meeting when we have a clearer understanding of our future workload.

The GMT expects to review the methodology for differentiating commercial catch in Federal waters from state waters noted in <u>Agenda Item F.8.a, NMFS Report 1, March 2023</u> between now and September. The GMT requests confirmation that the intent is for this review to be provided to National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS) directly prior to the September Council meeting and not in a statement to the Council.

Additional Meetings

Members of the GMT will also be participating in a number of ancillary meetings and work sessions outside of Council meetings over the next several months, both as members of the GMT and as part of their other duties. A non-comprehensive list is found in Table 1.
