

HABITAT COMMITTEE REPORT ON FUTURE COUNCIL MEETING AGENDA  
AND WORKLOAD PLANNING

The Habitat Committee (HC) discussed the June Pacific Fishery Management Council (Council) meeting set for Vancouver, WA. The HC requests to meet for two days (June 21-22) instead of one, due to several potential items that may be included on the HC's agenda, in addition to items currently on the Council's June agenda. These would require substantial additional time:

- Potential release of Draft Oregon Wind Energy Areas
- Potential actions related to the Office of National Marine Sanctuaries' YFD-70 Dry Dock Restoration Plan
- Potential release of proposed Chumash Heritage National Marine Sanctuary draft documents (Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, Draft Management Plan, Draft Environmental Impact Statement)
- Lower Columbia River Dredged Materials Maintenance Plan

In addition, the HC proposes tentatively planning a half day virtual meeting in late May or early June to discuss information related to Draft Oregon Wind Energy Areas, should they be announced prior to the June Council meeting.
